

SCHOOL UNIFORM

The school uniform is based upon smart, practical and reasonably priced clothing. All items must be clearly marked with the owner's name. Clarification on any appearance issues can be found on notices in tutor rooms.

- Plain black blazer
- White shirt or blouse with collar and sleeves in plain style
- School tie
- Black skirt/trousers – plain, black (NO casual, denim or fashion styles, NO knee length trousers)
- Black V-necked pullover or cardigan (Hooded or zipped tops are unacceptable)
- Belts – plain, black
- Shoes – plain, black (Training shoes are unacceptable)
- Socks – plain, black (or similarly very dark colour e.g. grey)
- Black or purple turbans (For Sikh students only)
- A black headscarf (For Muslim students only)
- A coat, raincoat, parka or anorak
- A bag, in which to carry belongings

HAIRSTYLES – hair must be of a natural hair colour. 'Tramlines' and similar detailing are unacceptable.

JEWELLERY is a serious health and safety issue for the school. As such we only allow items that pose the least risk. Students may only wear a watch, a single 5mm stud in each ear (silver or gold in colour, NO raised stones), a plain ring (NO raised stones, sovereign or similar types of ring) and/or a single bangle for religious purposes. Any other items will be confiscated and placed in the school safe for parents/carers to collect.
